#### **HU PECS01:**

- Selection process: the partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.

- · Services for incoming students:
  - Orientation Day is organized for international students each semester where students get information about the university in general, administrative issues, student activities, the Hungarian language course, and other services.
  - The ESN mentor system ensures the acculturation of foreign students by organizing a series of cultural and leisure activities.
  - Hungarian language (and culture) courses are offered for incoming students during the semesters
- For the implementation of STA/STT-mobilities, a letter of invitation issued by an UP contact person – is required.

SK BANSKA 01: The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation with Faculty of Arts, Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica.

- Students: The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period
  of study) must notify the International Relations Office (ingrid.balazova@umb.sk) about their
  interest in studying at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to the deadline.
  Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts.
- Foreign students coming to Banská Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN
- Students in Bachelor and Master study programmes must attend courses minimum: 20 credits per one semester; PhD. students minimum: 10 credits per one semester.
- Subject areas only in Slovak language: 225 History, 226 Philosophy and Ethics, 223 Mother tongue (Slovak language and literature), 813 Sports. Minimum recommended level B2.
- Staff: Teachers must notify the departmental coordinator about their interest in teaching at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to their arrival. The teaching plan and invitation letter will be signed by the Erasmus Administrator (ingrid.balazova@umb.sk).

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination or modification of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. The agreement will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate. This should be done in writing, and a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. The agreement can be cancelled activities can be added to it, and changes in mobility data can be made annually provided they are communicated before January 1.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

## 1. Grading systems of the institutions

#### **HU PECS01**

Code of Studies and Examinations: Section 48. (1) Assessment of student performance can be carried out according to:

- a) a five-grade scale: excellent (5), good (4), satisfactory (3), pass (2), fail (1),
- b) a three-grade scale: excellent (5), satisfactory (3), fail (1). (2)162 The student shall not earn credit points in case his/her performance is assessed by fail (1) in the five-grade scale and fail (1) in the three-grade scale, further, if the performance of the student could not be assessed and in the academic records the note 'not completed' is registered

**SK BANSKA01:** Grades:  $\bf A$  – EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors, ,  $\bf B$  – VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some error, ,  $\bf C$  – GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable error,  $\bf D$  – SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings, ,  $\bf E$  – SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria, ,  $\bf FX$  – FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded. The value of local credits corresponds to ECTS credits
