### D. Additional requirements

#### I PERUGIA06

Incoming students and staff are offered the opportunity to follow for free courses in Italian Language and Culture. The courses are organized accordingly to the model of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) in: Elementary (A1/A2), Intermediate (B1/B2) and Advanced (C1/C2). Students who pass the final exam receive ECTS credits reported in the Transcript of Records.

The University for Foreigners has an internal commission for disability which provides upon request specific teaching services and technical aids either for students, administrative staff and teachers (https://www.unistrapg.it/info-per/servizi-il-sostegno-degli-studenti-diversamente-abili/servizi).

#### SK BANSKA 01

The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation with Faculty of Arts, Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica.

Students: The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) must notify the International Relations Office (ingrid.balazova@umb.sk) about their interest in studying at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to the deadline. Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts.

Foreign students coming to Banská Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN UMB).

Students in Bachelor and Master study programmes must attend courses minimum: 20 credits per one semester; PhD. students minimum: 10 credits per one semester.

Subject areas only in Slovak language: 225 History, 226 Philosophy and Ethics, 223 Mother tongue (Slovak language and literature), 813 Sports. Minimum recommended level B2.

Staff: Teachers must notify the departmental coordinator about their interest in teaching at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to their arrival. The teaching plan and invitation letter will be signed by the Erasmus Administrator (<a href="mailto:ingrid.balazova@umb.sk">ingrid.balazova@umb.sk</a>).

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

This Collaboration Agreement may be terminated on the following grounds:

- End of the stipulated period of validity.
- · Mutual agreement between the parties.
- Written notice of termination with 6 months in advance, provided the termination shall not become effective until the end of the stay of the students enrolled in both institutions on the date of notification.
