**SK BANSKA01:** A type of certificate for students: a confirmation from sending institution (signed by a staff of university or faculty or department)

**RO GALATIO1:** It is assumed that the home university has selected their students and staff based on their language skills.

### D. Additional requirements

SK BANSKA 01: The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation with Faculty of Arts, Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica.

**Students**: The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) must notify the International Relations Office (<a href="mailto:ingrid.balazova@umb.sk">ingrid.balazova@umb.sk</a>) about their interest in studying at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to the deadline. Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts.

Foreign students coming to Banská Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN UMB).

Students in Bachelor and Master study programmes must attend courses minimum: 20 credits per one semester; PhD. students minimum: 10 credits per one semester.

**Subject areas only in Slovak language:** 225 History, 226 Philosophy and Ethics, 223 Mother tongue (Slovak language and literature), 813 Sports. Minimum recommended level B2.

**Staff**: Teachers must notify the departmental coordinator about their interest in teaching at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to their arrival. The teaching plan and invitation letter will be signed by the Erasmus Administrator (<a href="mailto:ingrid.balazova@umb.sk">ingrid.balazova@umb.sk</a>).

#### **RO GALATIO1:**

**Students**: The sending institution should send a nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) to the International Relations Office/Erasmus (<a href="mailto:bianca.chiosa@ugal.ro">bianca.chiosa@ugal.ro</a>) prior to the nomination deadline. An invitation will be released upon home university request.

Students must arrive at least 3 days before the academic year/semester starts.

Students in Bachelor and Master study programmes are allowed to attend courses of maximum 63 credits/academic year and 33 credits/semester.

Subject areas are only in Romanian; academic tutoring in English (min. B2 level) is provided.

**Staff**: Teaching and non-teaching staff should send (<u>dan.scarpete@ugal.ro</u>) their Teaching or Training Programme prior to their arrival at the "Dunarea de Jos" University of Galati. An invitation will be released upon staff request.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In case of earlier unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 June of year N will only take effect as of 1 September of year N+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

**SK BANSKA01:** Grades:  $\bf A$  – EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors,  $\bf B$  – VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some error,  $\bf C$  – GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable error,  $\bf D$  – SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings,  $\bf E$  – SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria,  $\bf FX$  – FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded. The value of local credits corresponds to ECTS credits.

**RO GALATIO1**: Marks from 1 to 10 (1-4=Fail; 5-10=Pass) The value of local credits corresponds to ECTS credits.

#### 2. Visa

The sending and receiving institutions will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outbound mobile participants, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.

#### **RO GALATIO1:**

Students from the European Union, the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not need a visa or residence permit to enter Romania. Within 90 days after their arrival, they simply need to register within Immigration Office, providing a proof of sufficient funding and health insurance coverage.

#### 3. Insurance

The sending and receiving institutions will provide assistance in obtaining insurance for incoming and outbound mobile participants, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education.

**SK BANSKA01:** The foreigner must submit a document confirming health insurance during the stay in the Slovak Republic. Students can arrange it in their own country.

RO GALATIO1: Students from EU member states should have a European Health Insurance Card.
