D. Additional requirements

TR IZMIR06:

- İZÜ (TR IZMIR06) organizes an orientation program each semester for welcoming incoming students. It is highly recommended to incoming students to participate in the orientation program because students are provided with vital information on course registration, campus accommodation, health issues, İZÜ's IT facilities and residence permit.
- İZÜ (TR IZMIR06) provides the infrastructure to welcome students and staff with disabilities and will try to support them according to their special needs. But partner universities are advised to contact the international office very early to make sure that the student concerned can be accepted.
- İZÜ also supports students and staff with disabilities if they want to go abroad.

SK BANSKA 01:

- A type of certificate for students: a confirmation from sending institution (signed by a staff of university or faculty or department)
- The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation with Faculty of Arts, Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica.

- Students: The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) must notify the International Relations Office (ingrid.balazova@umb.sk) about their interest in studying at the Faculty of Arts at Matej Bel University two months prior to the deadline. Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts.
- Foreign students coming to Banská Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN UMB).

E. Calendar

1. Applications/information on nominated students must reach the receiving institution by:

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In case of earlier unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 June of year N will only take effect as of 1 September of year N+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

1. Grading systems of the institutions

Grades: $\bf A$ – EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors, , $\bf B$ – VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some error, , $\bf C$ – GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable error, $\bf D$ – SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings, , $\bf E$ – SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria, , $\bf FX$ – FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded. The value of local credits corresponds to ECTS credits
