#### D. Additional requirements

# SK BANSKA 01: The candidates with disabilities can only be accepted after the consultation.

**Students**: The sending institution on the nomination letter (name, e-mail, area of study, period of study) must notify the International Relations Office at Matej Bel University two months prior to the deadline. Students must arrive at least 7 days before the academic year starts.

Foreign students coming to Banská Bystrica are automatically enrolled in the buddy system (ESN UMB). Students in Bachelor and Master study programmes must attend courses minimum: 20 credits per one semester; PhD. students minimum: 10 credits per one semester.

**Staff:** Teachers must notify the faculty departmental coordinator about their interest in teaching at Matej Bel University two months prior to their arrival. The teaching plan and invitation letter will be signed by the Erasmus administrator/coordinator.

#### At the receiving institution LT VILNIUS06:

- 1. All incoming students shall have to complete on-line application package at <a href="https://incoming.mruni.eu">https://incoming.mruni.eu</a>
- 2. Every incoming student is entitled to courses of 30 ECTS per semester.
- 3. Every incoming student upon arrival receives access to his/her electronic study records book at the University's information system "IS STUDIJOS".
- 4. Incoming persons with visual or moving disabilities are asked to contact the International students office (<u>erasmus@mruni.eu</u>) and they will be provided assistance by the responsible staff member.

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks after deadline of applications.
- 3. Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

In case of earlier unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 June of year N will only take effect as of 1 September of year N+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

LT VILNIUS06: Mykolas Romeris University uses a criterial ten-point grading scale for assessment of the learning outcomes and a cumulative nature of assessment is applied in order to ensure active work of students during the students. Cumulative assessment shall assess learning outcomes by means of interim evaluations. The final grade is made of the grades of interim evaluations and grades of the examination. Usually, the assessment of the examination makes 40-50 per cent of the final grade, whereas that of interim evaluations – 50-60 per cent.
