THE CITY

Banská Bystrica is a city in Central Slovakia located on the Hron River in a long and wide valley encircled by the mountain chains of the Low Tatras, the Veľká Fatra, and the Kremnica Mountains. With 78 327 inhabitants, Banská Bystrica is the sixth most populous municipality in Slovakia. The present town was founded by German settlers, however it was built upon a former Slavic settlement. It obtained the municipal privileges of a free royal town of the Kingdom of Hungary in 1255. The copper mining town acquired its present picturesque look in the Late Middle Ages when the prosperous burghers built its central churches, mansions, and fortifications. It is the capital of the Banská Bystrica Region and Banská Bystrica District. It is also the home of Matej Bel University. As a historical city with an easy access to the surrounding mountains, Banská Bystrica is a popular winter and summer tourist destination.

THE FACULTY OF ARTS

As a public higher education and scientific institution, the Faculty of Arts of Matej Bel University Banská Bystrica is the largest among the six faculties of Matej Bel University with its 2,003 students (as of 2015).



The fundamental tasks of the Faculty, according to the Statute of the Faculty of Arts, Matej Bel University Banská Bystrica, passed by the Academic Senate of Matej Bel University Banská Bystrica pursuant to Article 9 (1)(b) of the Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on higher education establishments, include:

- 1) providing and organising higher education in the accredited study programmes at all three degrees and further education and awarding academic, scientific and pedagogical titles;
- 2) conducting basic and applied research in line with the needs of the knowledge-based society and with the market needs. In educating students, it applies state-of-the-art knowledge in science and technology, and provides favourable conditions for their creative scientific research;
- 3) supporting scientific research and its application in practice and education;
- 4) conducting habilitation procedures and professor appointment procedures;
- 5) cooperating with other national and international higher education establishments and other education establishments;
- 6) supporting the academic staff to convey their research work to the academic world through publications;
- 7) cooperating with the job market,
- 8) creating conditions for educating and promoting of the academic staff.

The Faculty of Arts trains flexible professionals, who successfully work in the areas of culture, mass media, education, state and public administration, social, cultural and physical training institutions, private sector and the European institutions. Many of its graduates have become entrepreneurs, especially in the area of translation and interpreting.

The Faculty of Arts has long been cooperating with universities, professional bodies and governing authorities at home and abroad. literary science, translation and interpreting studies, social and cultural studies, historical and philosophical sciences, ethics and applied ethics, anthropology, ethnology, physical education and sports.

In the 2015/2016 academic year, 712 day and external students studied at the department in programmes focused on physical education, sports and coaching.

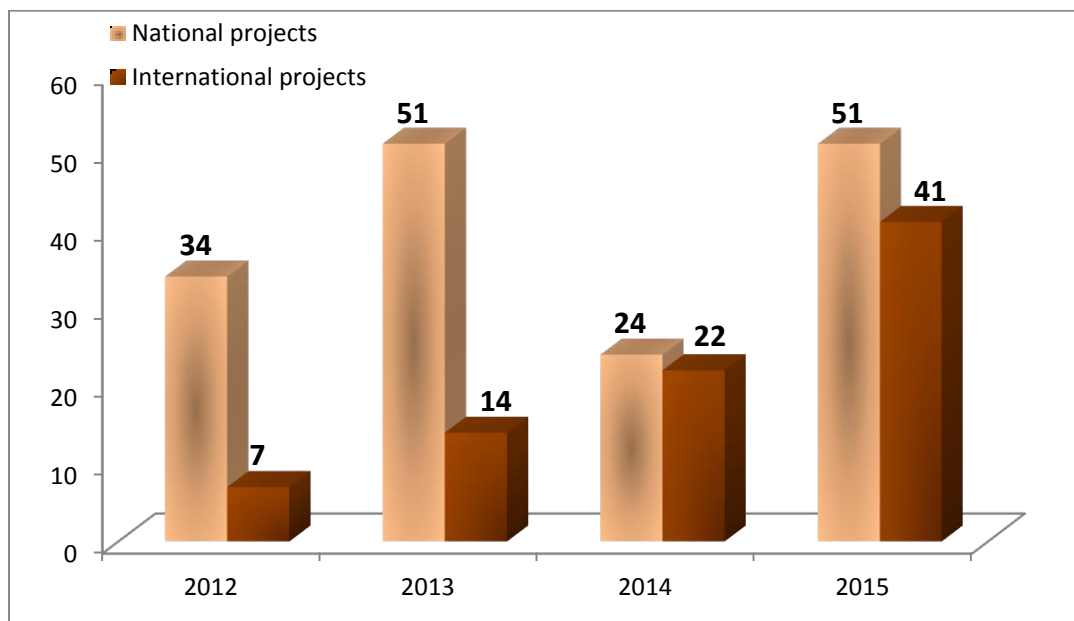

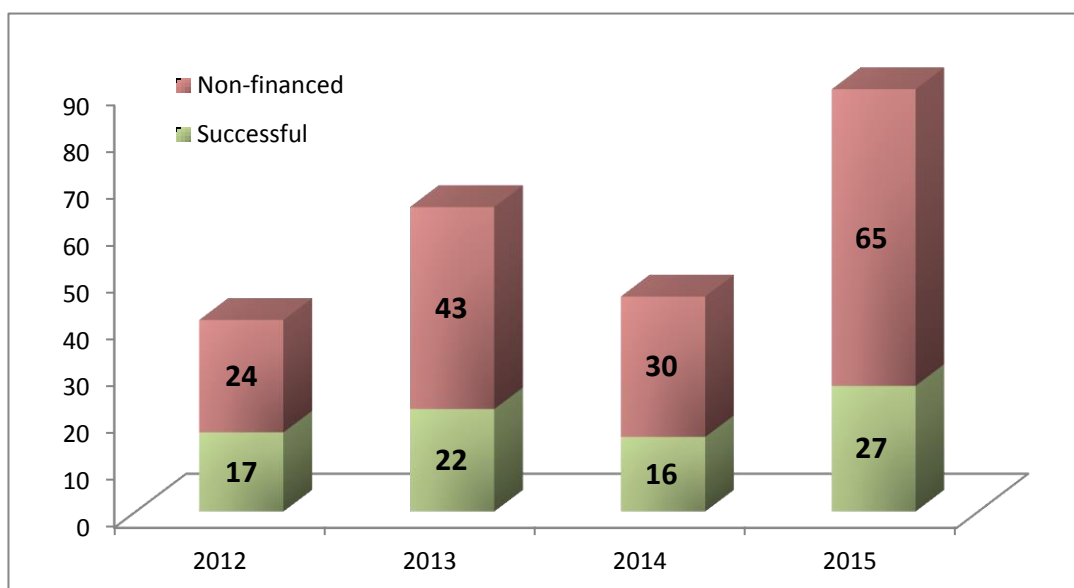

EXPERIENCE IN THE TOPIC
